White Peak Planning have been retained as planning advisor to The Radcliffe School as part of a longstanding involvement in the redevelopment of the sports college. We have successfully secured planning consent for a series of unique and technical proposals that come as a response to the growing demand for school places in Milton Keynes.

The first permission relates to successful delivery of new all-weather sports pitches and sports hall. We planned and undertook a comprehensive community consultation exercise, including Member Briefings, workshops with officers, Public Exhibitions and liaison with Sport England, British Cycling and local cycle groups.

The scheme posed numerous challenges, specifically due to its location adjacent to a new residential area. The all-weather pitches were close to residential properties, therefore we had to consider the potential impacts relating to noise, lighting and community use. The new indoor sports hall has now been delivered providing high quality indoor facilities.

The second permission relates to the demolition of an existing disused gymnasium and changing rooms and the construction of a new front entrance to the school and associated reception area, single storey rear lobby area and a two-storey Sixth Form block.

Most recently, we obtained permission for the provision of a temporary classroom in order to accommodate additional demand in the area.
